## **Key Themes in Jude:**

- 1. Jude's desire was to lift up salvation, but the necessity of clarifying distortion about Christ's message required him to lift up truth.
- 2. Exhortation: Urging people to live and convey the truth of Christ.
- 3. Jude provides instruction for the behavior and life of Christians.
- 4. Jude compels the Christians to reach out with the truth to those who do not know Christ.
